If you or anyone in your household has any of the following, we kindly ask that you call to reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician immediately. For a non-routine/urgent dermatologic concern, please call and ask for a clinical staff member.

Contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

Traveled internationally or been on a cruise in the past 2 weeks

Fever

Cough

Shortness of breath

Flu-like symptoms

When you arrive at your appointment, you will be asked a few questions. You'll be asked if you have been in contact with someone with confirmed COVID-19 and/or anyone with you has a fever, cough, flu-like symptoms or shortness of breath. You may be asked to reschedule your appointment and contact your primary care physician.

To protect the health of our community, we kindly ask that you do not bring any extra guests or children to your appointment if possible.

When scheduling an appointment:

You will be asked a few questions when scheduling your appointment. You'll be asked if you have been in contact with someone with confirmed COVID-19 and if anyone in your household has fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
